- This proposal will be submitted for peer review; acceptance is not guaranteed.
- If selected, the language submitted in this proposal will be used for marketing purposes.
- If selected, I will adhere to all deadlines, including those for submitting a presentation outline for accreditation purposes and submitting a final presentation for attendee distribution purposes.
- Panels are strictly limited to five (5) individuals total, including a moderator.

Compensation and Travel Expense
